Officer Transition: Bruce handed out responsibilities to incoming Vice President, Stan Ronk and Candy Lamb to incoming Secretary Berni Schyvinch.

Fountain Article: It will be discussed who will compose and send the article at the next board meeting.

Election Meeting: It was brought to the board's attention to have a sign up sheet for members and non-members for the next election meeting. A decision will be made by next year's board to charge for non-members for food. (Or to not serve food at the meeting.)
